

Erasmus+ Project “Me Too: Empathy for EU”
Assignment for the Meeting in Portugal (May 17-23, 2022)

You will work in mixed groups of 6 students: 3 visiting students (from Bulgaria, Sweden and The Netherlands) and their 3 Portuguese partners.

On the basis of what you will hear, observe, discuss, reflect, and learn during this week and on the basis of the preliminary investigation from the 4 countries,

you will produce...

... a short video about a specific real life actual case related to nature/climate. The video should end with questions for discussion and invite to action.

The videos will be published on the website of the project and spread to as many young people as possible.



Follow the steps below to make sure you are not missing anything.

On WEDNESDAY:

Step 1:

In your mixed group of 6, after presenting each other, please share:

a strong feeling that you personally have about nature/climate. Speak about something where your heart beats faster...

For example, something that amazes or fascinates you or something that you really love; or it could be something that really preoccupies you or makes you angry or sad. Speak about concrete cases, not just in general terms.

Step 2:

For your group, choose 1 (only one!!!) real life actual case related to nature and / or climate, which you will to explore together during the week.

Make sure you choose something interesting and relevant, something about which you really want others to think and act. Choose something challenging! (not something as obvious as “we all should put our garbage in the bin and not on the floor/on the beach”).

Write down the real life case you chose in your group and communicate it to the teachers (you can use classroom or email – or even a sheet of paper!).

During the week you will participate in several visits related to the ocean which might help you in your group project, in case you choose a topic related to the ocean.

On FRIDAY:

Step 3

You have 3 hours to produce together the **video about the real life case you chose**.

- a) Write down in one sentence which will be **the message** of your video.
- b) Decide how you want to develop your argument.
- c) Define the question(s) about which you want your audience to reflect in the end;
Define the action to which you want to invite your audience.
- d) Define what you need / want to film.
- e) Make sure the conditions for the sound are ok (make a test first!)

Be creative and innovative, think “out of the box”, don’t content yourselves with simplistic or obvious affirmations (like: “we should not pollute the ocean”)

Your final product should have about 5 minutes (not more!!!). Make sure that all group members participate.
